## Songs Summary

### WATCHIN' OUT 4 U

**Age Group:** Pre-primary – Year 3

**Description:** This song encourages students to consider the feelings of others who may be sad or playing on their own. The song suggests actions students can take to help their friends such as cheering them up, telling the truth and doing what you know is right.

### KEEP YOUR COOL

**Age Group:** Years 1–3

**Description:** This song has been written to encourage students to keep their cool if they are teased or bullied. The lyrics focus on positive strategies for dealing with a bullying incident such as looking someone straight in the eye, not shouting or fighting back, asking an adult for help or walking away.

### DR TONE

**Age Group:** Years 4-7

**Description:** This song aims to encourage an improvement in the 'tone' or ethos of the school by telling other students that they are not alone and to be supportive of their friends. This song has two versions, one with and one without a feature electric guitar.

### THE INNOCENT BYSTANDER

**Age Group:** Years 6-7

**Description:** The Innocent Bystander can be sung as a rap or spoken in time to the music. The lyrics touch on the importance of bystanders in reducing bullying and provide possible actions students can take if they see others being bullied.

### TWO WRONGS

**Age Group:** All

**Description:** Designed as a listening activity to sing along while analysing the words and story.
