

Cyber Leaders (2016-2017)

Aim

The Cyber Leader Project aimed to help build and develop students' leadership skills and knowledge of cybersafe practices, enabling them to support their peers to prevent or reduce harm from their online behaviour.

Methods

Involved the development of the <u>Cyber Leaders' Handbook</u>: a website for student leaders to assist them in their role leading the school community in the safe use of technology. The Cyber Leaders' Handbook is divided into nine modules organised under two themes to develop leadership skills and resources to build the student leaders' capacity to address cyber-safety and education proactively within their school community. The website was reviewed in 2017 in 10 WA non-government schools to gain students feedback and input on the Handbook.
